- Commission shall be charged at the following rates in respect of each lot, with a minimum charge of £4 per lot entered and an overall minimum charge of £5.00: - 10% on the first £2,500; 4% on the residue plus VAT** All commission rates are inclusive of advertising, cataloguing and incidental expenses.
- Please send a list of lots and photos to us before 22nd November so we can get them into the catalogue.** All items must be delivered to the salerooms **before Monday 2nd December.** All items remain the property of the vendor until sold and paid for and at the vendors risk. Any unsold items must be removed from the sale site on the sale day and remain the vendor's responsibility at all times.
- Any item unsold due to failing to meet reserve must be collected within two hours of the end of the sale. Failure to do so the item will be re-entered into the next sale without reserve.
